The Beaver M8D, built compact for ease of towing, is designed to handle a real workload.

A 32 cubic inch hydraulic motor provides plenty of brush pulling torque to the feed wheel.

The bolt-on mounting design allows a B-loc drive system to be used, protecting the hydraulic components.

The patented air impeller is integrated into the chipper housing to provide controlled airflow, assisting in carrying light, leafy material

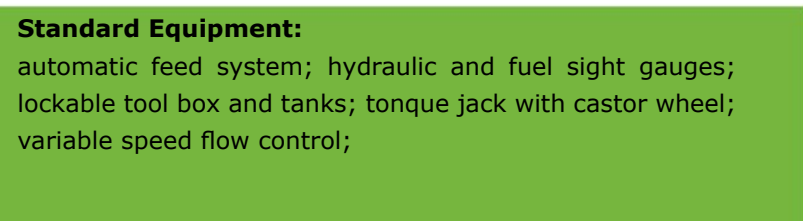
